Good Friday Tenebrae service at FPC The word "tenebrae" comes from Latin meaning "darkness." The Tenebrae is an ancient Christian Holy Week service that makes use of gradually diminishing light through the extinguishing of candles to symbolize the events of the week from the triumphant Palm Sunday entry through Jesus' death and burial.

Could you surrender yourself into the power of everything that is the opposite of what you are and believe? Could you do this for someone else? Someone who didn't care? Could you do this because of another's promise?

Jesus did. For forty hours, dead in a tomb, he fought death and the Devil, and shattered the gates of hell for all who trusted in him. That is the message of Good Friday and Easter morning. Christ, crucified and risen, for you, and for me.

That's what the rest of Lent and Holy Week and Easter prepares us for, and reminds us of. The first Sunday in April is our last Sunday of Lent. Palm Sunday, which officially is: Sunday of the Passion/Palm Sunday. We will process with palms and hear a dramatic reading of the Passion of the Christ. On Good Friday, if you do not go out at night, there will be a community Good Friday service at noon at the Franklin First United Methodist Church. Here at FPC, we will be having a Tenebrae service at 7 p.m.

Easter will begin with a Sunrise service at 6:11 a.m.. This will be followed by a breakfast and egg hunt. Then comes One Great Hour of Sharing. At our regular worship time, we will worship joyfully!

I have all of the lessons I am going to preach on for the services in the month of April picked and a tentative title given. Now, I have to get to work! I will be looking forward to seeing you, and your invited guests this month!
