# Pastor's Portion

June 4th we celebrate with wide eyed wonder the mind-boggling, spiritzapping, imagination staggering *Day of Pentecost*. The celebration of God's gift to God's church of the Holy Spirit. Our power to be the church, Christ's hands and feet and lips and voice in his world today.

**Pentecost!** A day when a handful of believers who huddled in an upper room became the bold bearers of the Gospel message, bringing 3,000 in one day to faith by the work of the Holy Spirit through them.

The exact number is not the issue. The issue is whether or not we are faithful to our calling to share the gospel of Jesus Christ. Rededicate yourself this Pentecost Sunday to carrying out God's mission. Will you proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ?

What is the Summer Feeding Program?

Participants form FPC pick up pre-made lunches at the local middle school and then transport and hand out lunches and milks at three locations in Franklin. This effort helps to ensure that children in our local community continue to receive nourishment when school is not in session.

We will pair up every day of delivery during the summer (2 people on each delivery day). To make sure that at least one person knows the ropes, please put an "X" by your name if you have participated in the past. If this is your first time helping with the Summer Feeding Program, just sign your name up with someone whose name has an "X" by it! Please also put "car" by your name if you are willing to drive that day (and if you have space for three small boxes, two large coolers, and the other person in your car).
