### **Educational Wing Renovation**

We have begun preparing for the renovation of the Educational Wing building here at FPC. Here is where we are in the process:

- Monday, January 28, 2019 Storage Container delivered.
  - Once the construction dumpster arrives, it will not be possible to drive from the College Street entrance around to the back parking area. You will need to access this off of Washington Street
- Tuesday, January 29, 2019 Moving company comes to move all the heavy items from the building.
- Saturday, February 2, 2019 Those who signed up to help with moving the rest of the boxes to the storage unit will begin at 9 am. Woon Yen Prall is coordinating the meal for the workers so thanks so much!
- Sunday, February 3 For the duration of the renovation, the following groups will meet in new locations:

Choir – practice in Sanctuary, music and robes stored in parlor.

Elementary Sunday School class – meets in basement

Middle/High School Sunday School – meets in parlor

Nursery will continue to meet in same location as now until the week before asbestos removal (Date TBA), then they will move to the Conference room.

- Decorating team to pick out floor tile, colors, etc. will be chaired by Diane Shutt. Let her know if you are interested in helping.
- Nursery team to help with relocation and needs after the move will be chaired by Sarah Halcomb. Let her know if you are willing to help.

As soon as the asbestos removal begins, the Educational Wing will be inaccessible to us. We will enter from the front or office side. We will likely also unlock the back door by the Gazebo, which will take you to the parlor.

At this point, it looks like renovations will be complete in May, but we will give you an update as firmer dates are given to us. Scott, Murphy, and Daniel is the construction company doing the work. They did the Lewis Home, are doing the Boys and Girls Club, and the Goodnight Library.

The Renovation Task Force would like to thank everyone in advance for their patience as this project unfolds. Feel free to call anyone of us if you have questions.

### Our Interim Search Committee is hard at work!

In case you were wondering about the process: 1) The Session completes a Ministry Information Form (MIF) approved by the Presbytery Commission on Ministry. 2) The MIF is posted online with the Presbyterian Church Leadership Connection for matching with prospective interims. 3) The Search Committee reviews Personal Information Forms, makes a selection, and recommends to the Session which contracts with the interim pastor. 4) The interim pastor leads the congregation in a mission study. 5) Toward the conclusion of the study, the congregation approves a Pastor Nominating Committee for an installed pastor. 6) The PNC takes the information from the mission study, completes a MIF that is approved by the Presbytery Committee on Ministry, and begins the process of seeking an installed pastor.

Where we stand now: Our church has been matched with several prospective candidates for interim. Please pray for the committee members: Woon Yen Prall, John Halcomb, Jim Sowney, Bob Thompson, Barbara Shriver, and Donna Houston as they discern who will be best to serve FPC during this transition time.


