Community Action has the following resources available to those in need:

- Food pantry Call Vicki at 270 586-3238
- Commodities distribution at Jim Roberts Park on 4th Tuesday of each month from 11:00-1:00. Must show proof that you are a Simpson County resident (driver's lisence or current utility bill). Be sure your trunk is clean as food will be put in there by the volunteers.
- Community Action has also extended their utility assistance until the end of July.

- On Wednesdays from 11-12:30 sack lunches are given to anyone who comes. No residency requirements.

Simpson County Schools

If you have school aged students, you may receive food Monday-Friday from 11:00 am-1:00 pm at Simpson Elementary or Franklin Simpson High School. Your child must be in the car with you. This delivery ends on May 22nd and the Summer Feeding Program begins on June 1.

Buses are also running their routes and delivering food. Times are 11:00 am-1:00 pm. The Backpack Program gives food to those who qualify each Friday so that families have food for the weekends.

If you lost your job due to COVID-19 be sure to apply for Unemployment. If you need help not covered here, call 211 and they will do their best to help fulfill your needs.

Franklin Presbyterian Church is doing all they can to "Be The Church" at a time when our doors are not open. We are praying daily for our community and are supporting many of the resources above.
