Pastor's Pen

Lent and Lament....

Beginning each new year always offers a chance to start fresh. And 2021 was no exception. Yet we experienced some unsettling things in our first month of the year, from the loss of beloved friends to the wobbly governmental transition, and it leaves us reeling a bit as we move forward. Praise be to God who sustains us!

Then we begin again into February, the shortest month and one that can often be enlightening as we lament. I have always loved the celebration of Black History Month in February. I have been a member of churches that utilized the contributions of Black Christians as part of the worship during February. As a White Christian, I sometimes found that unsettling because it forced me to acknowledge and confront some of my ancestral and current complicity in the treatment of Black folks in our nation. However, the tension of that lament and the celebration of the image of God so evident in our Black siblings is what makes it so memorable and enriching.

As we begin February, seek out the Black voices in your areas of interest. Who have you been listening to, whether music or art or business or theology or entertainment?

It's a good practice to think about as in the second half of February we enter the liturgical season of Lent, where we begin to contemplate and pray in preparation of the commemoration of the death of Jesus Christ and his triumphant resurrection. Lent is what we make of it, so entering into with a sense of awe and wonder and participation in a new introspection into our bodies and our heritage as American Christians could open our hearts and souls to the work of the Holy Spirit.

We will be working through the Psalms in our preaching during Lent and those Psalms of lament will hopefully resonate with our personal and communal journeys through this season. Also, there will be times of Bible Study and prayer available on Zoom and in the church social media sites. I encourage you all to participate as God leads you to commune with one another during this time to evaluate what God is calling us to do next.

The work of lament and the work of introspection in lent are difficult, yet the road of discipleship in Jesus Christ is one that involves ALL of who we are, our minds, bodies, souls, and spirits. Let us engage our God and each other in new and exciting ways!

The love, grace, and peace of Christ be upon you all!

We are excited to announce a Friday Fish Fry Fundraiser in February to help fund a Drop-In Center for those who need a hand up, not just a hand out. Let Debbie Wyatt know if you would like to order a lunch or more info about the Drop-In Center. You can pick up lunch from 11:30-1:00, but it will be first come-first serve. So if you know you want one, Debbie will make sure yours is held until you arrive. Free will offering, but it is for a great cause, so give generously.

We continue to get free eggs that we share with First Baptist. A huge food donation was given by Kentucky Downs so that food is being used for the Tuesday/Thursday lunches. Our own Joe Shumaker is a regular volunteer for this program. We were also approved to partner with Feeding America and will be getting food on a regular basis from them.

Another "new" program Matthew 25 is getting off the ground. Food vouchers from Piggly Wiggly and gas vouchers from Key Stop/BP will be available to help those in need. We budgeted \$1,000 from our grant to fund this endeavor.

Volunteer help is needed for the Clothes Closet and Feed the Need soup kitchen. We have been amazed at how the more we do, the more generous people are. God has definitely blessed this ministry!

If you know someone who could use a home cooked meal, your Fellowship Committee has you covered. We have been preparing entrees and soup and freezing them. They are in the refrigerator freezer on the right side, with a sign out sheet to whom they are being delivered. Feel free to make a delivery to someone you think could use it!
