### Pastor's Portion

#### A Spring of New Growth

It is with great joy that we celebrate the Resurrection this coming Sunday, and throughout this Season of Easter to follow. Now I'm not one who has a "green thumb" but even I know that in order to create new growth, a bit of pruning and trimming is needed. Even something more drastic at times.

We experience this through the death of Jesus Christ on Good Friday, the mourning amid Holy Saturday, and the unexpected and incredible joy of Easter Sunday. New growth in the Holy Spirit follows.




19 I will put in the wilderness the cedar, the acacia, the myrtle, and the olive; I will set in the desert the cypress, the plane and the pine together,


