

### **Asking the Right Questions**

As we enter into the final month of this winter, new questions arise in my understanding of where God is calling us as a church.

What should we be doing more?

What should we be doing less?

What new ministry is awaiting us?

What needs are there in the community that are not addressed?

How can we help more people?

These are all good questions, beloved. Yet I wonder if we are not getting ahead of ourselves. We are looking for solutions sometimes when we do not know the problems. Or we are offering a temporary help when the permanent options are more difficult.

Perhaps, even more telling, is that WE are the ones coming up with the answers. Instead, we should be asking the right questions.

I recently finished a book called *Having Nothing, Possessing Everything* by Mike Mather, a Methodist pastor who reminisces about the lessons he's learned in ministry in Indianapolis and South Bend. One thing that struck was something he said took him 30 years and a lot of criticism to understand, and that was to ask those folks the church is helping about themselves.

What do you like to do?

What is something you know so much about you could teach someone else to do? How would you like to help others yourself?

Yes, sometimes we ask those questions. Sometimes we just think them. I'm challenging myself (and so I'm also challenging you) to ask those kinds of questions. Maybe, just maybe, we'll learn more about our community and the people we are living and serving with and God will give us the answer to those first questions too.

May the grace of God, the love of Christ, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all this month!


