

Deep and Wide

Ever have those moments when everything seems to be a very big deal? When every time you turn to the Bible, there's a deep lesson the Holy Spirit is fixing to place upon your heart?

Recently, our experiences at Franklin Presbyterian Church reflect some deep thoughts, ways in which God is calling us to do and be more than ever for our community. Yet it's not always easy to do. As spring opens and shows us a new beginning, as the earth again brings forth life, may the Holy Spirit stir in us a deep desire to shout the good news that Jesus Lives, that death cannot hold him. Our deepest gratitude for God's grace finds its center in living out this Christian Life in prayer, in service, and in praise. The little things, the big things, and everything in between. May you feel the depth of God's love and the wideness of God's mercy all April long.
