

Pulling a Fast One

In like a Lion, out like a Lamb! Is this a familiar phrase to anyone else regarding March? Or did I create a false memory somewhere? Of course, this means that March can often begin with a roar, with cold blustery weather and the biting chill of winter... and then move on toward April with a gentle bleat, with the soft wool of spring's eternal hope.

Church life often means that March is Lent. The vagaries of the lunar calendar make the calendar placements of Ash Wednesday and Holy Week vary from year to year, but on the whole, March typically falls fully (or mostly fully) into the season of Lent.


Lent offers us a chance to enter this season of repentance and contemplation in different ways. We could enter sheepishly, wondering what our practices of fasting and prayer may provide, how we might attempt to get closer with God during this time. Or we might roll into Ash Wednesday with a roar, ready to tackle a vice or to institute a new healthy habit or spiritual practice.

No matter how we enter Lent, we might find ourselves leaving the season during Holy Week a transformed person, a transformed congregation, a transformed community. We might enter as a Lion and leave as a Lamb, or vice versa. The role of repentance and contemplation of our faith and our relationship with Christ is to transform us into being more and more of what God is forming us to be.

This is NOT a quick task or a speedy transformation! We can't "pull a fast one" on Lent, or on God. We must be patient to wander the wilderness, wherever the Spirit leads us, and to face times of trial, because in the hope that God provides us, we know that we are saved by the redeeming work of Jesus Christ.

Spend a little time in March delving into scripture, praying (or learning to pray - with Pastor Bailey's Tuesday class!), and seeking God in new and unexpected ways. A deeper dive into your walk with Jesus might just be a way to bridge winter to spring. And prepare for a celebration with the Risen Lord in April!
